Family Fun Night FAQ

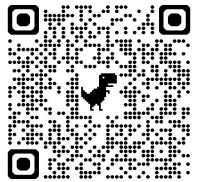
- **What am I signing up for?**

Pack 315 meets on Tuesdays at 7pm for an hour. We usually take the fifth Tuesday of the month off (when there is one). There are a few weekend activities including a Pinewood Derby (Jan) and a Family Campout (Apr). Scouting is a family activity and we encourage parents to participate. Much of scouting is Choose Your Own Adventure. A Pack Committee meets once a month to keep the program on track and we are always looking for new committee members.

- **Is this for my child?**

Cub Scouting is for EVERYONE! Boys and Girls are encouraged to participate in Cub Scouts. The Pack will frequently split up into Dens which are simply divisions by grade-level - (K) Lions, (1st) Tigers, (2nd) Wolves, (3rd) Bears, (4th) Webelos, (5th) AOL.

- **Do we have to do fundraising?**

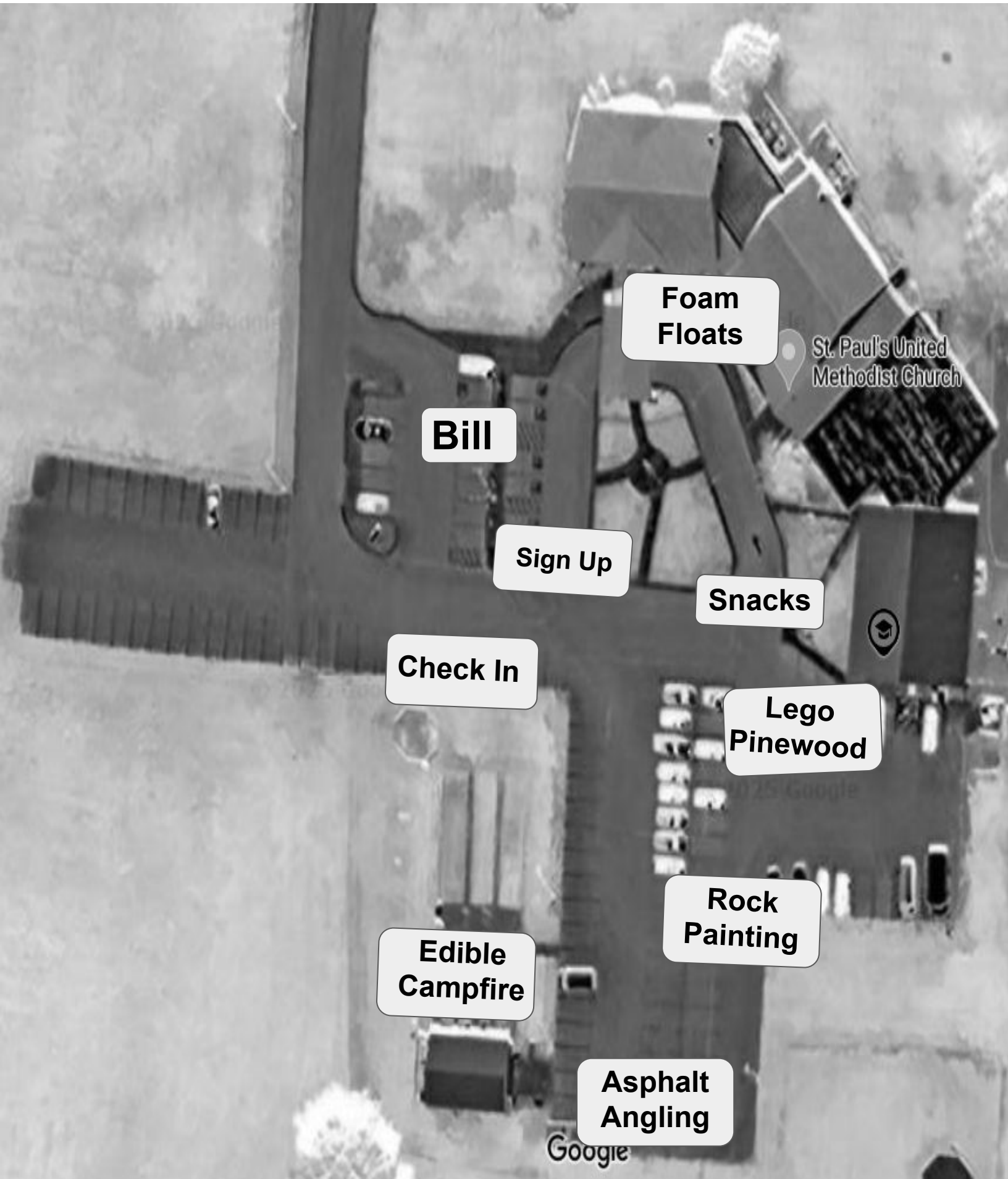
- **What does it cost?**

Scout dues are \$160 (\$124 National./Council & \$36 Local/Pack)

- **What is the uniform?**

Cub Scouting has two uniforms - Activity and Field Uniforms. The traditional button down is referred to as the 'Field Uniform' or Class A and is encouraged for formal gatherings like Flag ceremonies and Pack meetings. For most Scout functions, an 'Activity Uniform' or Class B will be enough.

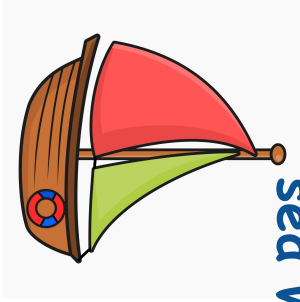

Construct a racecar from the supplied lego pieces. Present your car for inspection and race check-in with the scout attendant.

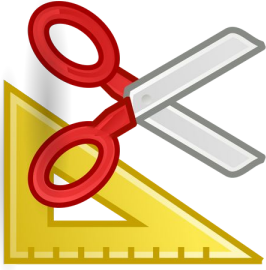
